Review the gospel and encourage your child to speak with you if they have questions. Remind your child that faith is essential to the Christian life. Also, without faith it is impossible to please God. Then **pray, praising God that Jesus came to save sinners and asking Him to help us follow Him by faith.**


Peter Worshipped Jesus

BIBLE PASSAGE: **Luke 5**

KEY PASSAGE: **Hebrews 11:6**

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: *How can we be saved?*

We are only saved through faith in Jesus.



One day, Jesus stood by a lake as He taught about God's Word. Crowds of people gathered together, pressing in to hear what Jesus was saying. Jesus looked out and saw two boats at the edge of the lake. The fishermen were out of

the boats, washing their nets.

Jesus got into one of the boats and asked a fisherman named Simon Peter to push the boat a little out from the land. Then Jesus sat down and taught the crowds from the boat.

When Jesus was finished speaking, He told Peter to move the boat to deeper water and let down his nets to catch fish.

Peter said, "Master, we've been fishing all night long and didn't catch anything. But I will do what You said."





So Peter and his partners—James and John—let down the nets. They caught so many fish that the nets began to tear. They called out to the fishermen in the other boat to come and help. Both boats were so full of fish that they began to sink. The fishermen were all amazed.

Peter fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord! I am a sinful man!"

Jesus said, "Don't be afraid. From now on, you will be catching people." Then Peter, James, and John brought the boats to land, left everything, and followed Jesus.

Peter understood that he was a sinner and recognized that Jesus is God. He responded to Jesus' grace and kindness by following Him. When we understand that Jesus is God and that we are sinners, we can turn to Him for forgiveness and follow Him by faith.
