Dear Parents,

Thank you so much for allowing your child to join our service. I'd love for you to use this newsletter to review this week's Bible story with your child at home.

Today, we'll learn that "Jesus Calmed a Storm" (Matthew 8; Mark 4; Luke 8). In our Bible story, Jesus did sleep during a scary storm because He was in complete control of the storm. Every wave obeys Jesus as well because He is God. As the Son of God, Jesus is both fully God and fully human.

Review the gospel and encourage your child to speak with you if they have questions. Remind your child that the disciples reaction to the storm was one of fear, but it was also a response that showed their lack of faith in Jesus' goodness. Discuss how they asked Jesus if He didn't care they might die. Explain that the truth of the matter is Jesus loved them and cared for them so much, He left heaven and came to earth to die for their sins. Then **pray**, **thanking God for Jesus' power over sin and death.**

BIBLE PASSAGE: Matthew 8; Mark 4; Luke 8

KEY PASSAGE: John 1:18

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: Is Jesus God or a human?

As the Son of God, Jesus is both fully God and fully human.

Jesus opened His eyes and saw that His friends were afraid. He got up and spoke to the wind. Then Jesus said to the sea, "Silence! Be still!"






At the sound of Jesus' voice, the wind stopped blowing and the waves stopped crashing.
