Dear Parents,

Thank you so much for allowing your child to join our service. I'd love for you to use this newsletter to review this week's Bible story with your child at home.

Today, we'll learn that **"Jesus Fed Many People"** (Matthew 15; Mark 8). *In our Bible story, we will learn that Jesus performed a miracle to feed a hungry crowd. Jesus multiplied seven loaves of bread to make enough to feed over four thousand people. Later, Jesus called Himself the Bread of Life.*

Review the gospel and encourage your child to speak with you if they have questions. Remind your child that God has not promised to answer our every request for what we may want, but that He has promised to meet our needs. God is always with us and cares for us. Tell them that the greatest way Jesus has shown compassion and love toward us is through the cross. Then **pray, thanking God for meeting our greatest need by sending Jesus to die for our sin.**

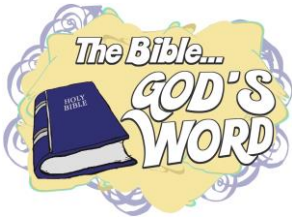
Jesus Fed Many People

BIBLE PASSAGE: **Matthew 15; Mark 8**

KEY PASSAGE: **John 1:18**

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: *Is Jesus God or a human?*

As the Son of God, Jesus is both fully God and fully human.



Jesus had been traveling with His disciples in an area where Gentiles—or non-Jews—lived. He healed people and taught people about God. Jesus looked at a large crowd of people and had compassion on them. They had been with Jesus for three days, and some had

come a long distance to meet Him. They had nothing to eat.

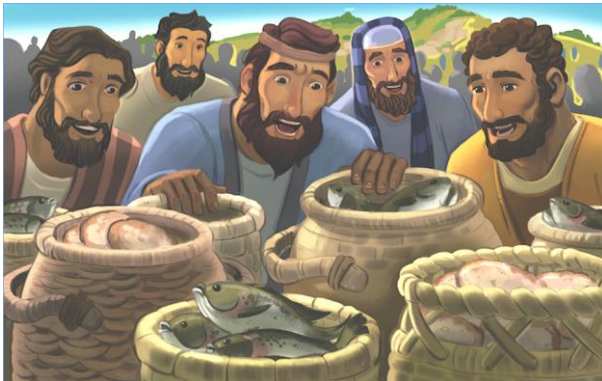
Jesus told His disciples, “If I send them home, they will collapse on their way.”

The disciples said, “We are not near a city. Where can we get enough bread to feed them?”

Jesus asked, “How many loaves of bread do you have?”

The disciples answered, “Seven.”

Jesus told all the people to sit down. He took the seven loaves, gave thanks to God, and broke the bread into pieces. He gave the





bread to His disciples to serve to the crowd. The disciples also had a few small fish, so Jesus blessed the fish and served them too.

Everyone ate and was satisfied. The disciples collected seven baskets full of leftover pieces. Jesus told the crowd—four thousand men plus women and children—to go home. Then Jesus and His disciples got into a boat and left that place.

By feeding the crowd, Jesus provided for the physical needs of the people. Later, Jesus called Himself the Bread of Life. (John 6:35) Only Jesus can satisfy our souls forever by providing forgiveness, peace with God, and eternal life.
