Dear Parents,

This week, we have the opportunity to explore the teachings of **“Moses’ Farewell”** (Deuteronomy 31-34).

At 120 years old, Moses told the Israelites he would not enter the Promised Land, but God would go before them. He encouraged them to be strong and trust in God as Joshua became their new leader. Moses wrote down God’s laws, blessed the people, and saw the land from Mount Nebo before he died. This story reminds us that while Moses could not lead the people into the land, Jesus leads us into eternal life with Him.

This message will inspire your child to grow in the love and light of Jesus. Reinforce the lesson at home by discussing the following points with your child:

- ☐ **God Goes Before Us:** Moses told the Israelites not to fear because God was with them. How does knowing God is with us help us?
- ☐ **Obeying God’s Word:** Moses wrote down God’s laws to guide the people. Why is it important to listen to and follow God’s Word?
- ☐ **Jesus, Our Perfect Leader:** Joshua led Israel into the Promised Land, but Jesus leads us to eternal life. How can we follow Jesus today?

You might consider praying with your child, **thanking God for His guidance and asking Him to help you trust and follow Jesus every day.**

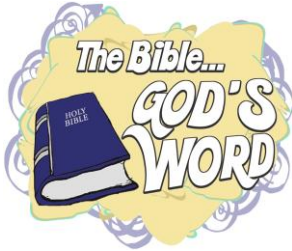
Moses' Farewell

BIBLE PASSAGE: Deuteronomy 31-34

KEY PASSAGE: Romans 8:28

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: *Why should we obey God?*

**We should obey God because He made us, He loves us,
and His plans are good.**



When Moses was 120 years old, he gathered the Israelites together. He told them, "I can no longer act as your leader. God has told me that I will not go with you into the Promised Land. The Lord will cross ahead of you. He will destroy the nations, and you will drive them out.

Joshua will be your leader. Be strong and courageous, do not be afraid, because the Lord will go with you and will not leave you."

Moses wrote down all God's laws and gave it to the priests. He said, "Take this book of the law and place it beside the ark of the covenant of the Lord. Be careful not to disobey God after I am dead as you have in the past. I know you will do evil in the Lord's sight and disaster will come to you."

Before his death, Moses blessed the people. He gave a special blessing to each one of the twelve tribes of Israel. To all of Israel, he said this:



"There is no one like God,
who rides the clouds to help you.
He drives out the enemy before you.
How happy you are, Israel!
Who is like you,
a people saved by the Lord?

He is the shield that protects you.
He is the sword you fight with.
Your enemies will be defeated.”

Then Moses went up to the top of Mount Nebo. From this mountain, he could see the land God had promised. Moses the servant of the Lord died there, just as God had said. The Israelites cried for Moses for 30 days.

The Israelites turned to their new leader, Joshua. They would obey him, just as the Lord had said to Moses. He would lead them into the Promised Land.

Moses led God’s people faithfully but died unable to bring them into the Promised Land. Jesus leads us in perfect faithfulness. He died so that all who place their faith in Him will join Him in the new heaven and earth.
